

CXA-202-11 Implementing Citrix XenApp 5.0 for Windows Server 2008 Skills Update

This course provides the foundation necessary to effectively deploy and administer Citrix XenApp 5.0 and its components, including Web Interface, application streaming and Secure Gateway. Learners will receive hands-on training for installing XenApp and Plugins and for using the various administrative consoles to configure policies, individual server and server farm settings, isolation environments, streaming applications and much more.

Audience

This course is intended for IT professionals, such as server, network, systems and help desk administrators with experience administering Microsoft® Windows® environments containing Citrix Presentation Server 4. Systems engineers, analysts, consultants, and architects with Citrix Presentation Server 4 experience are also appropriate candidates for this course.

Preparatory Recommendations

Before taking this course, Citrix recommends that learners have experience using Windows Server 2008, including an understanding of Active Directory, policies and profiles and knowledge regarding administering users, home directories, user profiles and security. Learners should also have previous experience administering Citrix XenApp (Presentation Server 4.0 or higher), or completed the following courses:

- CTX-1256AI Citrix Presentation Server 4.0: Administration or CTX-1259AI Citrix XenApp (Presentation Server 4.5): Administration

- Create a configuration logging database.
- Configure application streaming for XenApp.
- Install and configure Web Interface.
- Identify the additional components included in the XenApp Platinum edition.
